# MAJOR REQUIREMENTS



- Complete the following courses with a grade of “C” (2.0) or better in each course:
  - ACCT 101; ECON 103; ENG 151, 152, or ENG 153; COMS 101 or 103; MATH 163A; SASM 201; SASM 225
- Achieve and maintain an accumulative g.p.a. of 2.5 or higher
- There are no exceptions

# Sport Management Program Application



- When you have successfully completed all pre-major classes, get the program application from your academic advisor and complete the top section of the form.
- Then, take the completed form and your current DARS to your advisor for approval by your advisor and the Sport Management Coordinator.
- Take the form to Grover W370 and complete a change of major form.
- Make sure that the business minor code is added.

# COURSE SCHEDULING

- **Class Rotation (Fall 2009)**
  - BUSL 465 in Fall MW 8-10am
    - ✦ Typically offered F/W/Sp
  - SOC 233 in Fall M-Th 8-9am
    - ✦ Typically offered F/Sp
  - ECON 318 will be offered W/Sp
- **Tier III**
  - SASM 450 – Senior Seminar (WF 10-12)
    - ✦ 2009-10 will be offered F/W

# Course Scheduling (2)



- **Fall Electives**

- **SASM 440 - Ticket Operations (MW 2-4)**

- ✦ **Required for Sales Certificate**

- ✦ **Only time offered during 2009-10 – Sales Certificate candidates MUST register for this class during the fall.**

- **SASM 400 – Diversity and Sport (MW 10-12)**

# Course Scheduling (3)



- **REMINDER!**
  - OPN 310 does NOT automatically meet the requirements for the Business Minor
  - Sport Mgmt students should register for OPN 300
  - Any substitutions for the Business Minor require approval of the College of Business

# Course Scheduling (4)



- **SASM 301/376 cluster**
  - SASM 301 and 376 will be taught as a cluster class for the FALL ONLY.
  - You must register for BOTH concurrently by obtaining permission from Dr. Lawrence and Mr. Wright (must show DARS with prerequisites) – send email with registration access DAY & TIME to get on registration list.
  - The courses will be taught separately in W/Sp

# PLANNING FOR GRADUATION



- When planning for graduation (at least one full year before graduation), keep in mind the following:
  - Not all required courses are offered every quarter
  - Summer courses may not reach the required enrollment to be offered; if any course you need for graduation is cancelled during the summer, you will need to take the course during the fall quarter

# Planning for graduation (2)



- Required courses may have time conflicts.
- You should take **ONLY SASM 400-LEVEL COURSES** and electives during your final quarter on campus (preferably your final 2 quarters).
- You can search for Tier III course options using the course offerings menu (SASM 450 is one choice of many).
- **YOU are responsible for making sure you have met all graduation requirements**
- **Do not expect to substitute for a required major course**
